21 THE PETITIONER: NO, YOUR HONOR.

6 THE COURT: LET'S GO BACK ON THE RECORD ON THE
7 ROBERTSON VERSUS ZULLO MATTER, 17FL00138.

8 MS. ROBERTSON, WILL YOU PLEASE STEP FORWARD?

9 THE PETITIONER: MR. SERRANO IS ON ZOOM.

10 MR. SERRANO, MS. ROBERTSON IS ON -- IS IN THE
11 COURTROOM, AND THE PRIOR TO THE LUNCH HOUR, I ASKED YOU
12 TO HAVE YOUR CLIENT HERE IN THE AFTERNOON.

13 WHY IS HE NOT IN COURT?

14 MR. SERRANO: YOUR HONOR, THERE'S BEEN AN
15 IRREMEDEABLE BREAK DOWN OF THE ATTORNEY-CLIENT
16 RELATIONSHIP, AND WE'RE ASKING TO BE RELIEVED AS ATTORNEY
17 OF RECORD.

18 THE COURT: ALL RIGHT. I NOTICE YOUR MOTION.

19 MR. SERRANO, WOULD YOU PLEASE NOTICE YOUR
20 MOTION, AND MAKE SURE YOU HAVE THE DOCUMENTS FILED. I
21 USUALLY HEAR THOSE ON FRIDAY, SO YOU CAN NOTICE IN THE
22 MEANTIME, AND WE'D BE HAPPY TO ADDRESS THAT ISSUE AT ANY
23 TIME IN THE FUTURE. BUT FOR PURPOSES OF TODAY, YOU
24 REMAIN ON UNTIL I GET THIS MOTION FROM YOU.

25 MR. SERRANO: UNDERSTOOD.

26 THE COURT: MR. ZULLO, PLEASE TURN YOUR CAMERA

1 ON. ALL RIGHT. THE RECORD'S GOING TO REFLECT IT'S NOW
2 1:59 IN THE AFTERNOON. MR. ZULLO IS NOT PRESENT IN THE
3 COURTROOM. MS. ROBERTSON IS HERE, SO THE COURT IS GOING
4 TO CONDUCT IT'S ACTIVITY WITHOUT MR. ZULLO BEING HERE IN
5 PERSON.

6 THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS IS, MR. ZULLO, I'M
7 GOING TO PUT THIS IN THE MINUTE ORDER, AND I DON'T KNOW
8 IF YOU'RE LISTENING TO ME OR NOT, BUT I'M GOING TO MAKE
9 SURE MAKE THAT YOU HEAR IT AND IT MAKES IT INTO THE
10 RECORD.

11 THE LAST TIME THIS MATTER WAS SET, YOU MADE SOME
12 DISPARAGING COMMENTS TOWARDS A JUDICIAL COLLEAGUE OF
13 MINE, COMMISSIONER SOLIS, AND I'M GOING TO WARN UNDER
14 CALIFORNIA CODE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE SECTION 1209, THIS
15 COURT WILL NOT TOLERATE YOUR BEHAVIOR TOWARDS A JUDICIAL
16 OFFICER. I'M PUTTING YOU ON NOTICE THAT ANY RUDE,
17 INSOLENT, INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR THAT INTERRUPTS
18 PROCEEDINGS FURTHER WILL RESULT IN CONTEMPT.

19 CONTEMPT IS SUBJECT FIVE DAYS IN JAIL PER
20 OCCURRENCE AND \$1,000 PER OCCURRENCE UNDER CALIFORNIA
21 CIVIL CODE OF PROCEDURE UNDER 1218. THE FIRST ORDER OF
22 BUSINESS FOR ME IS, YOU'RE NOT HERE, SIR, THAT'S A DIRECT
23 VIOLATION OF THE PREVIOUS COURT ORDER. SO FOR THAT, I'M
24 GOING TO SANCTION YOU \$1,000 FOR NOT TURNING ON YOUR
25 CAMERA AND NOT BEING IN COURT. THAT'S GOING TO BE
26 PAYABLE IN 30 DAYS FROM TODAY, AUGUST 14TH, 2023 CLOSE OF

1 BUSINESS.

2 YOU ARE REQUIRED TO PAY \$1,000 FINE FOR NOT
3 ABIDING BY THE COURT'S ORDERS. THE COURT'S GOING TO MAKE
4 THE FOLLOWING RECORD: AT THE LAST PROCEEDING MR. ZULLO
5 WAS ORDERED BY JUDGE -- COMMISSIONER SOLIS TO APPEAR
6 TODAY IN PERSON. HE HAS NOT MADE AN APPEARANCE THIS
7 MORNING IN PERSON. FOR SOME REASON, MR. ZULLO APPEARS TO
8 BE ON ZOOM. I DID NOT GRANT HIM PERMISSION TO BE HERE ON
9 ZOOM. THEREFORE, YOU ARE IN DIRECT VIOLATION OF
10 COMMISSION SOLIS'S ORDER.

11 I'M GOING TO READ INTO THE RECORD WHAT THE ORDER
12 WAS. THE ORDER FROM JUNE 2ND, 2023 INDICATED THAT THE
13 MATTER WAS CONTINUED TODAY, JULY 14TH, 2023, 8:30 IN THE
14 MORNING IN THIS DEPARTMENT FOR FURTHER HEARING. THE
15 CITEE, MS. ROBERTSON, WAS ORDERED TO APPEAR IN PERSON ON
16 THIS DATE, AND MR. ZOOLOO (PHONETIC) -- I'M SORRY.
17 MR. ZULLO WAS ORDERED TO APPEAR IN PERSON ON THIS DATE,
18 AS WELL. HIS FAILURE TO APPEAR -- HE'S FAILED TO APPEAR.
19 THEREFORE, THE COURT IS GOING TO ISSUE THOSE SANCTIONS AS
20 INDICATED EARLIER.

21 THE HEARING NOW IS BEING CONDUCTED VIA ZOOM, AND
22 CIVIL CODE OF PROCEDURE SECTIONS 367.75 INDICATES THAT
23 THE COURT MAY CONDUCT PROCEEDINGS VIA ZOOM OR IN PERSON.
24 IN THIS PARTICULAR INSTANCE, GIVEN THE NATURE OF THE
25 CASE, IT'S A CONTEMPT MATTER THAT WAS FILED BY MR. ZULLO.
26 MS. ROBERTSON HAS BEEN HERE BEFORE. THERE'S

1 BEEN NO EXCHANGE OF DISCOVERY ON THIS CASE TO ALLOW
2 MS. ROBERTSON TO PREPARE HER MATTER. THE COURT REQUIRES
3 THAT EXCHANGE IN DISCOVERY. MR. ZULLO IS NOT HERE. I'M
4 ALSO ORDERING MR. ZULLO TO TURN OVER DISCOVERY OR PROVIDE
5 DISCOVERY TO MS. ROBERTSON OR HER COUNSEL BY THE CLOSE OF
6 BUSINESS ON AUGUST 14TH AT -- AUGUST 14 END OF BUSINESS
7 BY 5:00 P.M.

8 FAILURE TO PROVIDE DISCOVERY TO MS. ROBERTSON OR
9 COUNSEL WILL RESULT THE COURT DISMISSING THIS MATTER
10 PURSUANT TO PENAL CODE SECTION 1385 AT THE COURT'S
11 DISCRETION FOR FAILING TO ABIDE BY THE COURT'S ORDERS.
12 I'M PUTTING YOU ON NOTICE, MR. ZULLO, YOU ARE NOT TURNING
13 YOUR CAMERA ON. YOU ARE NOT RESPONDING TO ME, AND YOU
14 ARE NOT AVAILING YOURSELF OF THIS COURT.

15 SO, MS. ROBERTSON, BEFORE THE LUNCH HOUR, I
16 ASKED YOU HOW MUCH TIME YOU NEEDED TO BE PRESENT THE NEXT
17 TIME WITH YOUR LAWYER. DO YOU HAVE A DATE IN MIND?

18 THE PETITIONER: I HAVE NOT FOUND AN ATTORNEY
19 YET. IT'S HARD TO GET ONE BECAUSE MR. ZULLO ATTACKS ALL
20 OF MY ATTORNEYS.

21 MR. SERRANO: YOUR HONOR, MAY I BE HEARD
22 BRIEFLY?

23 THE COURT: GO AHEAD, MS. SERRANO.

24 MR. SERRANO: THE ONLY COMMUNICATION THAT I WAS
25 ABLE TO OBTAIN THAT MAY BE RELEVANT FOR TODAY'S PURPOSES
26 IS THAT MR. ZULLO IS APPARENTLY EXHIBITING COVID-19

1 SYMPTOMS. AND FOR THAT REASON WAS INDICATING THAT HE WAS
2 NOT PERMITTED TO BE PRESENT IN PERSON.

3 THE COURT: MR. SERRANO, I'LL TAKE YOUR
4 REPRESENTATION AS AN OFFICER OF THE COURT THAT THAT IS
5 HIS EXCUSE. IF THAT'S THE CASE, I NEED PROOF OF THAT,
6 AND I WILL CONSIDER VACATING MY ORDER FOR \$1,000 IN
7 SANCTIONS IF HE PROVIDES ME ADEQUATE PROOF THAT HE HAS
8 COVID.

9 THE PROBLEM THAT YOU ARE UNAWARE OF, MR.
10 SERRANO, THIS CASE HAS BEEN AN ON-GOING ISSUE IN THIS
11 COURT HOUSE -- IN THIS COUNTY QUITE FRANKLY WITH
12 MR. ZULLO, AND THIS COURT IS NOT GOING TO ENTERTAIN
13 MR. ZULLO'S TACTICAL REASONS FOR DOING THINGS.

14 IN THIS PARTICULAR INSTANCE, I AM MAKING A
15 FINDING THAT HE HAS INTENTIONALLY FAILED TO ABIDE BY
16 COURT'S ORDER, THE ORDER TO BE HERE TODAY. THE COURT
17 -- HE'S FAILED TO ABIDE BY OTHER ORDERS OF THIS COURT,
18 SPECIFICALLY TO TURN ON HIS CAMERA. SO I DON'T KNOW WHAT
19 HE IS DOING BACK THERE. THERE IS A MESSAGE ON CHAT WHERE
20 HE IS REQUESTING TO BE UNMUTED, AND HE SAYS, "I CAN'T
21 HAVE A RESTRAINING ORDER." I DON'T KNOW WHAT THAT MEANS.

22 NEVERTHELESS, HE IS NOT AVAILING HIMSELF TO ME.
23 I'M MAKING MY ORDERS. I'LL PROVIDE HIM WITH A MAIL COPY
24 OF MY ORDERS, AND AN E-MAIL COPY OF MY ORDERS. THOSE
25 ORDERS FOR 30-DAY REQUEST TO PROVIDE THAT INFORMATION TO
26 MS. ROBERTSON OR THE COURT IS FINE.

1 THERE'S A MESSAGE ON THERE THAT HE HAS A
2 RESTRAINING ORDER; HE CAN'T CONTACT MS. ROBERTSON.
3 THAT'S FINE. MR. ZULLO CAN PROVIDE THE DISCOVERY TO THIS
4 COURT. I WILL PROVIDE IT, THEREAFTER TO MS. ROBERTSON'S
5 ATTORNEY. SO YOU CAN HEAR ME, MR. ZULLO, BECAUSE YOU'RE
6 RESPONDING. SO YOU ARE ORDERED TO PROVIDE THAT DISCOVERY
7 TO ME TO THIS DEPARTMENT IN PERSON IN PAPER ON OR BEFORE
8 THE CLOSE OF AUGUST 14TH, 2023, OR THIS CASE WILL BE
9 DISMISSED PURSUANT TO P.C. 1385 AT THE COURT'S
10 DISCRETION.

11 ALL RIGHT. I'M GOING TO MAKE A SCREENSHOT OF
12 THIS. THE COURT IS GOING TO FIND MR. ZULLO IN CONTEMPT,
13 DIRECT CONTEMPT OF THE COURT UNDER 1209. THE REASON IS
14 AS FOLLOWS: IT'S NOW 2:07 IN THE AFTERNOON, AND
15 MR. ZULLO HAS INDICATED IN HIS CHAT THAT I'M GOING TO
16 PRINT. THAT HE WANTS -- "UNMUTE ME, IDIOT" IS THE WORD
17 HE PUT ON THERE.

18 MR. ZULLO, THAT'S DIRECT CONTEMPT OF THE COURT.
19 IN ADDITION TO THE \$1,000 FINE, I'M GOING TO ORDER YOU TO
20 SHOW UP ON THE 14TH IN PERSON AND PROVIDE ME AN
21 EXPLANATION OF WHY I SHOULDN'T ADD TO THOSE FINES OR WHY
22 I SHOULDN'T PUT YOU IN JAIL ON THAT DATE.

23 I AM NOT GOING TO ALLOW YOU TO ADDRESS ME
24 BECAUSE THIS IS HOW YOU SPEAK. MA'AM, HOW MUCH TIME DO
25 YOU NEED?

26 THE PETITIONER: I REALLY DON'T KNOW, YOUR

1 HONOR. THE LAST ATTORNEY I HAD MR. ZULLO REALLY -- HE
2 HAD TO GET A RESTRAINING ORDER, AND IT'S REALLY HARD TO
3 GET AN ATTORNEY, SO I DON'T KNOW.

4 THE COURT: I'LL MAKE THAT DECISION FOR YOU.

5 THE PETITIONER: I WAS HOPING THAT THIS COURT
6 COULD BE DISMISSED TODAY BECAUSE I'VE BEEN COMING HERE
7 EVERY TIME, AND HE IS NOT SHOWING UP. I FEEL LIKE I'M
8 WASTING MY TIME.

9 THE COURT: I MADE CERTAIN ORDERS, SO IF WE
10 DON'T GET THE INFORMATION THAT WE NEED BY AUGUST 14TH, I
11 AM GOING TO DISMISS THIS CASE. IT DOESN'T MATTER HOW
12 MANY INSULTS MR. ZULLO PUTS ON THE ZOOM CAMERA. IT'S NO
13 PROBLEM. WE ARE GOING TO TAKE RECORD OF THOSE AND DEAL
14 WITH THOSE ACCORDINGLY.

15 I'M GOING TO ORDER YOU BACK HERE 60 DAYS, MA'AM,
16 IN PERSON. I'M MAKE IT -- MAKE YOU SHOW UP HERE ON
17 FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER THE 15TH, 8:30 IN THE MORNING FOR
18 FURTHER ARRAIGNMENT. ALL RIGHT. THAT MEANS YOU DO NOT
19 QUALIFY FOR THE SERVICES AN ATTORNEY. SO WHAT I'M GOING
20 TO DO TODAY IS CONTINUE YOUR ARRAIGNMENT.

21 BY PUTTING YOUR ARRAIGNMENT OVER AND CONTINUING
22 IT TO SEPTEMBER 15TH. DO YOU UNDERSTAND AND AGREE THAT
23 YOUR TRIAL ON THIS CASE WILL NOT HAPPEN UNTIL 45 DAYS
24 AFTER THE 15TH OF SEPTEMBER.

25 THE PETITIONER: UH-HUH.

26 THE COURT: IS THAT A YES?

1 THE PETITIONER: YES.

2 THE COURT: TRY TO GET A LAWYER BEFORE THEN, AND
3 WE WILL LET YOU KNOW ON THE 14TH IF THIS CASE WILL BE
4 DISMISSED ON THE 15TH, SO YOU DON'T HAVE TO WORRY ABOUT
5 THAT. DO YOU UNDERSTAND WHAT I MEAN?

6 THE PETITIONER: YES, YOUR HONOR.

7 THE COURT: I NEED DISCOVERY FROM MR. ZULLO, AND


